Last day to see the first international Helsinki Photo Festival!

The **Helsinki Photo Festival** has successfully enabled residents, tourists and photo enthusiasts during six weeks to experience contemporary fine art photography in the metropolitan surroundings of the Teurastamo abattoir, Hermanninpuisto, Kalasatamanpuisto and Sörnaistenlaituri. Pop-up gallery Galleria Futura in Kellohalli's premises also provided new works for Nordic and international photographers to be exhibited.

The festival theme of "Love" showcased ambitious, innovative and the contemporary in photography curated by **Helsinki Photo Festival** team. There were more than 30 photographic artists selected in the festival some that never been seen in Finland (see all artists, title names and countries below).

"This has been a great experience" says Danish Louise Scheel who visited Finland for the first time and had an opportunity to meet other Nordic artists and speak about her art in the **Nordic Artists-Talks**. Swedish photographer Johannes Frandsen from Stockholm "felt it was a great event". He came to Helsinki to release his new book "Touch me" (Kerber Verlag & Ärk Förlag). Frandsen has documented the virtually unique Swedish phenomenon of *Dansband* that has emerged in the space between Swedish dance, rock and swing. Also, new dystopian works were displayed by Norwegian artists Astrid Gjersøe Skåtterød, Charlie Fjätström, Tor S. Ulstein and Swedish Will Vickers.

At the last day of the festival, the most experienced artist photographer Danish Birgitta Steen, who has been active since 1971 and still working with exhibitions and press photography will carry out the last Artist Talk in Galleria Futura.

The Nordic Village, the epicentre of the festival, located in the Teurastamo yard and Hermanninpuisto is set up against a backdrop of music and food festivals and other cultural happenings. The Nordic Village introduced novel state-of-the-art modular-shaped photography-based installations functional to display large-scale sized images for the use in public spaces and galleries. The structures were also set up in Kalasatama district, presenting a new way on how to experience and get access to contemporary photography, at any time of the day and night. The installations were designed in collaboration with Aalto University's School of Arts, Design and Architecture program of Spatial Design, Paja&Bureau, Saas Instruments and Helsinki Photo Festival ry.

Helsinki Photo Festival introduced **Inside Out**, **the people's art project by** to the streets of Helsinki and Pietarsaari in Northern Finland, drawing attention to a taboo topic in Finnish society. The project titled **"We are no different, we are all Finnish!"** intended to break preexisting language barriers with the use of portrait photography and reach all Finns whether Swedish or Finnish speaking. It aims to achieve a visual connection between these two realities, which throughout history has led to misunderstandings and often racism-related issues, envy and hate.

Although "this was the first international Helsinki Photo Festival, it will not be the last!" says Rafael Rybczynski, the Festival Director, who is preparing for the next edition to be bigger and better. "I have learnt many lessons along the way. The ambition was to have this event rolling from the beginning, but with little funding and shortage of volunteers, we were able only to do it step by step. The way, I imagined the festival to be, turned out positively to be during the last two weeks!"

Many thanks need to be given to the Danish Arts Foundation, Helsinki City, Canon Finland, the Nordic Embassies from Norway, Denmark, Sweden and Iceland, Skuggaland, Teurastamo and Kellohalli for providing support and funding during the event. Also, a big 'Thank You' goes to the many volunteers, helpers and photography students from Novia University in Pietarsaari and the Vocational School in Helsinki.
